COVID-19 EMERGENCY SUPPORT FUND FOR ORGANIZATIONS RESPONSIBLE FOR CULTURE, HERITAGE AND SPORT

The **COVID-19 Emergency Support Fund** provides support to organizations responsible for culture, heritage and sport. The objectives of this fund are to stabilize the sector while maintaining jobs and promoting business continuity for organizations whose cash flows and short-term operational viability have been affected by the COVID-19 pandemic.

Canadian Heritage recently launched the first part of the fund's second phase, which represents \$ 53 million in support to organizations with heritage collections through the Museum Assistance Program.

Non-profit organizations, such as museums, archives, historic sites, Aboriginal organizations, official language minority communities or municipal and university museums with a separate budget, are eligible to submit a funding request.

SECTORAL SUPPORT

DISCOVERY GRANT PROGRAM

The Government of Canada's **Discovery Grant Program** supports basic research in a wide range of natural science and engineering disciplines, including biology, mathematics and statistics, computer and artificial intelligence, chemistry and chemical engineering. New knowledge in these fields will allow breakthroughs in virology, pharmaceuticals and other applications in the years to come.

To apply to the program, applicants must meet the eligibility criteria for faculty members (https://bit.ly/3etvlke) and present a research program that is eligible under the mandate of the Natural Sciences and Engineering Research Council of Canada.

Active Discovery Grant recipients have the option of having their grant extended for one year depending on their current funding level.

Applicants have until August 1 to submit a notice of intent and until November 1 to submit an application.

Public health experts recommend that we:

- Limit our contact with other people by practicing social distancing;
- Frequently wash our hands for a minimum of 20 seconds;
- Use an alcohol-based sanitizer if we don't have access to water and soap;
- Cough and sneeze in a tissue or in the crux of our arm
- Avoid touching or eyes, nose or mouth if we haven't previously washed our hands;
- Use approved sanitizers to clean hard surfaces;
- Clean surfaces that are frequently touched (telephones, door handles, etc...)
